Early Identification / Intervention Priorities Addressed: To Collect information about local Emergency Department responses to overdose; Explore opportunities to promote more effective continuum of care transitions. Collect information about local school and community based efforts for screening, early identification and intervention activities that prevent early first use of tobacco, alcohol and other substances at or before ages 12-14; Explore opportunities for expanded screening. To deliver community education activities related to Trauma Informed Care.

Treatment Priorities Addressed: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In partnership with NH Providers Association, regional health care collaboratives, facilitate a group of SUD treatment providers in the region to promote communication and collaboration.2. In partnership with local treatment providers, promote activities to raise awareness for a Trauma Informed Community, and public understanding of addiction as a chronic illness.3. In partnership with local and regional resource and referral networks, build and maintain a current listing of existing treatment services and raise community awareness of the need for expanded local treatment options, accessible to Medicaid, Medicare, and the uninsured.
