	Anika/Kingswood School District- Would like to focus on community engagement, including sharing information about suicide prevention with parents and getting the community more involved outside of the school. (Good systems in place for responding to kids in crisis, training high school students to work with peers, trained all counselors, working on training all staff, Systems of Care grant with Northern Human Services, and building connections with Huggins Hospital and the Wolfeboro Police Department).	Kingswood did a screening of Anxious Nation for the community/parents.

Can collaborate with Jillian for New Futures Work. C3PH is still waiting on final word regarding funding.
