Alternative Sentencing Program

- Expanding capacity courts overwhelmed with opioid related cases
- o 80-85% referrals to therapist are coming from law enforcement
- Launching "Substance and Solutions"
 - Referred by court or community
 - Standard intake
 - Screening including SBIRT
 - o 3 MLADC
- o Needs reliable/dependable Recovery Coaches
- o 24 hour hotline MWV Supports Recovery & Whitehorse
- Launch date tent 2 weeks
