- Review of Early Childhood Priority

Group review and discussion of Goal and Objectives:

Goal: Make Carroll County a place where families can access resources to raise healthy and thriving children so they can live and work in the County.

Objectives:

1. Increase Lead Poisoning Prevention awareness and increase blood lead level testing rates in the County.
2. Increase awareness and understanding of Home Visiting resources in the county for families and providers.
3. Increased information and support for first-time parents and parents of children with special needs.
4. Increase communities' ability to promote resilience amongst families and young children
5. Increase options for families to access quality childcare in the County.

Group was supportive of this Priority, Goal, and Objectives. Discussed specific needs of quality childcare options in the Ossipee area – it was recommended that this is something that Ossipee Roundtable can assist with. Discussed the role of Social Determinants of Health – this new CHIP will have a section dedicated to SDOH. Include the success of outreach counselors/family support liaisons. New Futures is updating County Level Kids Count Data.

- **Training Opportunities**

Schelley will work with training coordinator and present training options at the next SCECC meeting. Caleb and Cathy will collaborate with MWV ECC to explore a joint training on collective impact with Emily Benson.

- **Participant Updates**

Children Unlimited: Closed until 12/15 – positive case identified in Preschool program. Clinic and Family Resource Center still providing remote services.

Crossings: Conducting Crossing meetings remotely. Small but committed participant group and remote technology allows meetings to cover more regions of the County. Farm to Table provides meals for each meeting and they are delivered by volunteers – this allows families to eat together for a portion of the meeting.

White Horse: Experiencing some struggles connecting with families via remote counseling, but it does work well for some families.

Central NH VNA: Still conducting home visits, following COVID and PPE protocols.
