  - Participation and resource sharing at various community groups/organizations related to health, human services, housing, transportation, student wellness, rural health and job development, recovery, IDN Region 7, faith community, hospital emergency departments, treatment providers, Hub & Spoke
  - Collaborations have led to successful events/happenings:
    - Promotion and technical support for 211NH integration across agencies  
Local video produced by IDN7 funding to highlight collaborative efforts across agencies to respond to substance use disorder.
