DISCUSSION	The DEA National Prescription Take Back Day was well represented by Carroll County Law Enforcement. Local Police Departments participating in the day included Bartlett, Conway, Jackson, Madison, Tamworth, Tuftonboro, Moultonborough, Sandwich, Wakefield, and Wolfeboro. The Carroll County Sheriff's Office also participated. We collected 692 pounds of unwanted medication.			
	There are now permanent collection boxes in Conway, Moultonborough, Madison, Wolfeboro, and the Carroll County Sheriff's Office. Locations are in the lobbies of each agency.			
CONCLUSIONS	At this time most local Police Departments are participating. Small departments often have difficulty covering the Take Back events and conducting normal business.
